

In pursuance of commencement of the ensuing Academic Session, attention is drawn towards the constitution of Board of Studies for each faculty in connection with finalization of syllabus of BA. LL.B(Hons), B.Com (Hons.), BMS, MBA, Five Year integrated course in Journalism and Master of Journalism & Mass Communication under the existing ordinances governing to the courses:

- A. There shall be a Board of Studies for every subject or group of subjects, as may be decided by the Dean of the School concerned and approved by the Vice-Chancellor.
- B. The Board of Studies shall consist of:
1. Head of the department- Chairman. If the Board has been constituted for more than one subject, the Vice-Chancellor shall nominate the Chairman.
 2. Three teachers, each from the category of Professor, Associate Professor and Asstt. Professor of the subjects nominated by the Vice-Chancellor.
 3. Two Experts having experience in the Industry or Academia or Research Organization etc. nominated by the Vice-Chancellor.
- C. The term of the nominated members shall be three years.
